



The Mr.Limpy size 1 measures in at roughly 3 1/2 inches long and is the smallest size available. It is ordering size #1.

The size 2 Mr.Limpy is about 6 inches long and is a jump from size #1. It is ordering size #2.

B - Available in sizes 2 and 3



The size 3 Mr.Limpy measures in at 6 1/2 inches and is ordering size #3

Making packers available since now

What is a Packer?

The term "packing" refers to the process of creating a male-looking and/or male-feeling bulge at one's crotch.

This can be done through the use of a prosthetic device that looks and feels remarkably like a penis.

Many trans men and trans masculine individuals "pack" simply for the sake of creating a realistic bulge in their pants. Others may wear one for certain occasions, such as when wearing tight fitting pants.

It is important to remember that some people regard "packing" as an inaccurate description of this process, as the prosthetics can be viewed as an extension of the self.

So what is this "Undercover Initiative downstairs" business all about anyways?

Our goal is to make both binders and packers available for members of the community. No mailing address or credit card necessary! As the Undercover Initiative is a project of the non-profit UVic Pride Collective, we aim to deliver subsidized binders and packers to anyone in need.

Can anyone get one?

Sure. We want to create a service for everyone. Demo packers will be available to examine, and order forms will be provided in the washroom, discreetly.

Which company provides the packers?

The packers themselves are Fleshlight series Mr.Limpy's and Pride is ordering them through the Pinkcherry.ca site. Other packers may be made available later or by request if possible.

How do I know what size to buy?

Buying a packer that's right for you can be tricky, and different for everyone. The Undercover Initiative has sample packers for you to get an idea of the sizes and colors. Holding the packer against your body can give you a better idea of how it might look, or even in your pants (but not your underwear) to see how it would go with your clothes.

How do I take care of my packer?

Your new packer is made from Fleshlight material, which according to their website is made from "real feel superskin" and is not made out of plastic, latex or silicone. Cleaning is simply a matter of soaking and rinsing the packer in warm water. Do not use soap or boil the packer as this will damage it. The easiest way to clean your packer is to shower with it and let it air dry.

Tips:

- Not sure how your new packer should sit? Take a look at www.erectionphotos.com to get an idea of how the penis sits on the body.
- Make sure your packer sits comfortably and you can use cornstarch or non talcum based powders that are safe for the genital area

How much will my packer cost me?

\$10 - \$15. Demo packers will be available so that you can test them out before ordering. Please keep in mind that contributing more than the minimum if you are able helps subsidize the cost for others who really need packers. And don't worry about the shipping cost either.

How is it supposed to... you know... stay?

There are a few different options when it comes to securing your packer in place.

- Briefs: Most packers can be worn inside a pair of close-fitting briefs. However, be careful when going to the washroom, as your packer can fall out when removing your underwear.
- Jock straps (with the cup removed) can also be used to hold your packer in place while wearing boxers or loose fitting articles of clothing.
- Certain performance/compression shorts have a pouch designed for a protective cup that also accommodates a packer. An example is the Microfiber Compression Boxers available through Underworks.com
- There are also a number of specifically made packer harnesses available all over the internet if you have the means to purchase them. These can be accommodating to a variety of needs.
