

Events Volunteer

Description: UVic Pride often hosts events both on and off-campus, this can include events such as Cinecenta movie screenings, invited speakers, dances, clothing swaps, marches, tabling at local festivals, Pride social nights, and many others. Events volunteers are meant to be more general volunteers, those who are able to sign-up to work at various events and help with things such as set up, take down, clean-up, directing traffic or people, etc. The responsibilities depend on each event! UVic Pride also works in collaboration with many other organizations both on campus and in the community, and there may also be opportunities to volunteer for other organizations' events, if they ask for our support.

Events Volunteers will be joined by Safer Spaces Volunteers, and often Office and/or Collective Coordinators, at various events.

Duties:

- Duties will vary according to each specific event.

Expected time commitment:

This will vary depending on the scheduling of each event. Event Volunteers will be asked to sign up to volunteer at events that they are available to help.

Training Provided:

- Orientation to UVic Pride, Movie Nights and Safer Spaces
- AOP Training

Accountability and Guidance: The Office Coordinator, or other designated Collective Coordinator, is the Event Volunteer's first point of contact, for guidance and access to any additional training if necessary. The Office Coordinator will check in with the Event Volunteers regularly to ensure that everything is going well, and to clarify any issues and questions.

Remuneration: This is an unpaid volunteer position. Volunteers will have access to training and professional development from UVic Pride and/or the Anti-Violence Project. Volunteer appreciation events will be held at least once per semester. Food will be supplied for all volunteers to meet and greet with each other and form connections.
