12.) Peter Singer Presentation

Because we were unable to gain collective approval before the Peter Singer presentation, the UVic Pride coordinating committee issued a statement on behalf of the coordinating committee condemning the event, and Pride members independently organized a vigil for the Disabilities Communities Day of Mourning.

VOTE: Add the statement issued by the coordinating committee to the Public Statements and Positions section of uvicpride.ca APPROVED.

13.) Movie Night

VOTE: Approve spending of up to \$50 to use for a film screening event where Pride shows Moonlight. APPROVED.

14) Policy Updates

15.) SFU Research Survey

We have been approached to participate in a research survey about "Cross group contact" and relationships between queer/trans communities and others.

We will begin to look into funding possibilities to arrange a UVic Pride camping trip over the summer.

VOTE: The Events and Activism coordinator will strike a working group to begin planning a summer camping trip. APPROVED.

A6) "Queerlition"

The Office Coordinator has been invited to sit on a committee of different youth service provider organizations in town to plan monthly events for queer and trans youth.

VOTE: Approve the office coordinator to sit on this committee as an official representative of UVic Pride, and to include duties related to this committee as part of their office hours to the collective. APPROVED.

A7) Rainbow Health Co-Op Event Consultation

Following our decision not to pair with Rainbow Health Co-op on their upcoming community event, they have responded asking for clarification about why Pride chose not to participate. VOTE: Approve Suela and Ocean to respond with information about the police's relationship with queer and trans communities, as well as Pride's stance on some of our issues with the event. APPROVED.
